

REGULAR SESSION January 4, 2021

The City Council of Gilbertville, Iowa met in Regular Session Monday, January 4, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic the meeting was held electronically (by Zoom meeting) and conducted in conformance with the Governor's Proclamation of Disaster Emergency dated March 19, 2020. Mayor Thome called the meeting to order. Council members present: Even, Frost, Meinert and Becker. Quorum present.

Motion by Meinert, seconded by Corbin to approve the January 4, 2021 regular session agenda. Ayes - Four. Motion carried.
