Consent Agenda

Public Comment – Bob Demuth requested his son buying 6<sup>th</sup> street between 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> Ave. Public Works Director (PWD) Werner stated there is a sewer line running through there. Demuth said nothing would be built on it. Brustkern suggested sending adjoining property owners a letter. Mayor Thome said any fees would be the responsibility of the purchaser. We will get a price, notify adjoining property owners and get back to Demuth.

Randy Mangrich questioned what the rules and regulations are for ATVs, he said they are driving in the parks. Mayor Thome said they are to be registered and to be driven on the road. He will talk to Police Chief Evans.

Reports:

Police – Parts are on back order to install equipment in the new police vehicle and should be ready soon.

Public Works – PWD Werner said they will be coming in May to do the storm sewer in Schmit Park .Getting equipment ready for summer.
