

REGULAR SESSION April 17, 2023

The City Council of Gilbertville, Iowa met in Regular Session Monday, April 17, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Thome called the meeting to order. Council members present: Perry, Even, Frost, and Becker. Brustkern was absent. Quorum present.

Mayor Thome led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Even seconded by Perry to approve the following items on the consent agenda: a) Agenda for April 17, 2023; b) Minutes for the April 3, 2023 regular meeting; c) Payments of bills, transfers and receipts and d) Utility Billing report for March 2023. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Motion by Becker, seconded by Perry to approve a Vendor Event request for May 13th at Double Take Salon and to allow Simply Amy's Boutique trailer to park curbside in front of the Double Take Salon. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Motion by Frost, seconded by Becker to approve quotes for street repairs from Aspro for \$47,900 and Kluenser Construction for \$7,728.75. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Motion by Becker, seconded by Even to approve switching Department Heads to salary positions, and changing PTO to vacation at the beginning of the new fiscal year (July 1, 2023). Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Motion by Becker, seconded Even to approve the second reading of Ordinance 358 amending provisions pertaining to the compensation of the Mayor. Roll call vote. Ayes Four – Motion carried.

Motion by Even, seconded by Frost to approve the second reading of Ordinance 359 amending provision pertaining to the compensation of the City Council. Roll call vote. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Motion by Even, seconded by Lisa to approve Resolution 2023-13 repealing Resolution 2023-10 and approving the Mayor's appointment of a designated voting alternate to the Black Hawk County Metropolitan Area Transportation Policy Board. Roll call vote. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Mayor Thome reported the Building Committee is meeting with the Architect and an Interior Designer to pick out floor and wall coverings Wednesday.

Reports:

Becker reported he attended the MPO meeting and projects are out until 2028 but the city could apply for TAP funds that could be used for a Main St. Project.

PWD Werner reported the brooms are supposed to be delivered this week for the street sweeper and he plans on sweeping if it rains.
