

REGULAR SESSION May 1, 2023

The City Council of Gilbertville, Iowa met in Regular Session Monday, May 1, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Thome called the meeting to order. Council members present: Even, Frost, Brustkern and Becker. Perry was absent. Quorum present.

Janice Rosauer gave the invocation and Mayor Thome led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Becker seconded by Brustkern to approve the following items on the consent agenda: a) Agenda for May 1, 2023; b) Minutes for the April 17, 2023 regular meeting; c) Payments of bills, transfers and receipts and d) Utility Billing report for April 2023. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

No water/sewer disconnections.

Motion by Becker, seconded by Frost to approve the third reading and final adoption of Ordinance 358 amending provisions pertaining to the compensation of the Mayor. Roll call vote. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Motion by Even, seconded by Becker to approve the third reading and adoption of Ordinance 359 amending provisions pertaining to the compensation of the City Council. Roll call vote. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Mayor Thome opened the public hearing to amend the FY 2022-2203. No written or oral comments are on file. Motion by Even, seconded by Frost to close the public hearing at 6:04 p.m. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Motion by Even, seconded by Becker to approve Resolution 2023-14 adopting the second Amendment for the FY 2022-2023 budget. Roll call vote. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Motion by Brustkern, seconded by Even to receive and place on file a resignation from the Deputy Clerk. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Motion by Becker, seconded by Even to post and advertise for a Deputy City Clerk. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Motion by Even, seconded by Frost to approve hiring two applicants to assist with mowing and other maintenance duties and to approve Resolution 2023-14 setting pay. Roll call vote. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Motion by Frost, seconded by Even to table discussion on changes to PTO time to Vacation/Sick and consult with the City Attorney. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on the Emergency Services building and it was decided to have a work session with the Architect as soon as possible.

Motion by Becker, seconded by Frost to adjourn at 7:18 p.m. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.
