Motion by Becker, seconded by Perry to open the public hearing for the FY 2024 budget amendment at 7:09 p.m. Ayes - Five. Motion carried. No written or oral objections were on file.

Motion by Even, seconded by Frost to close the public hearing at 7:10 p.m. Ayes – Five. Motion carried.

Motion by Frost, seconded by Brustkern to approve Resolution 2024-07 approving the FY 23/24 budget amendment. Roll call vote. Ayes – Five. Motion carried.

Motion by Even, seconded by Perry to table signs at city parks. Ayes – Five. Motion carried.

Motion by Frost, seconded by Brustkern to approve the first reading of Ordinance 364 repealing and replacing Chapter 47 Park Regulations. Roll call vote. Motion carried.

Motion by Perry, seconded by Even to waive the second and third reading of Ordinance 364 and place on file final adoption. Roll call vote. Motion carried.

Motion by Perry, seconded by Brustkern to approve the third reading and adopt Ordinance 364 repealing and replacing Chapter 47 Park Regulations. Roll call vote. Aye – Five. Motion carried.

No action taken on Fireworks.

Motion by Becker, seconded by Perry to approve a quote for street repairs for 6th St. and 12th Ave. @ Legion, 15th Ave. from 5th to 6th St. and at 16th Ave. and 4th St. Ayes – Five. Motion carried.

Motion by Becker, seconded by Frost to approve installing an electrical box at City Park. Ayes – Five. Motion carried.

Motion by Even, seconded by Brustkern to adjourn at 7:48 p.m. Ayes – Five. Motion carried.
