The City Council of Gilbertville, Iowa met in Regular Session Monday, June 1, 2020 at 7:00 P.M. Motion by Becker seconded by Even to approve Ordinance 335 adding New Section (145) parking in Residential Districts. Roll call vote. Ayes - Four. Meinert voted nay. The Ordinance adds a new section (Parking in Residential Districts). Any vehicle parked outside of an approved garage shall be parked on concrete, asphalt, gravel or similar surface. Grass is not an approved parking surface.

Ord 335 2<sup>nd</sup> reading

Motion by Becker seconded by Even to waive the third reading and place on file final adoption of Ordinance 335. Roll call vote. Ayes – Two. Meinert, Frost and Corbin voted nay. The motion did not pass and the Ordinance will be on the next agenda for the third reading.

Motion by Even seconded by Corbin to set date for cleanup day to the first Tuesday in August if that is available with Black Hawk Waste and to have it curbside this year due to COVID. Ayes- Five. Motion carried.
