

REGULAR SESSION June 20, 2022

The City Council of Gilbertville, Iowa met in Regular Session Monday, June 20, 2022. Mayor Thome called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Council members present: Becker, Even, Perry, and Brustkern. Frost absent. Quorum present.

Rita Becker gave the invocation and Mayor Thome led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Even, seconded by Perry to approve the following items listed on the consent agenda: a) Agenda for June 20, 2022 regular meeting; b) Minutes of the June 6, 2022 regular session; c) Payment of bills, transfers and receipts; d) Utility Reconciliation for May 2022 and e) Approve John and Kelly Grahams membership application to Gilbertville Fire & Rescue. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Consent Agenda

Randy Mangrich questioned why a prescription drop box has not been installed and Mayor Thome said he would get an update from Chief Evans. Discussion was held on Golf Carts/UTV/ATVs not meeting regulations when being operated. A driver has to have a valid Driver's License and at least 18 years of age and many are not following the speed limit. A reminder of regulations will be posted and in the newsletter. Violators can be fined or lose registration could be revoked.

Public Comment

Motion by Becker to approve Resolution 2022-11 setting pay with a 4% increase (police officers, public works employees and city hall staff) and a merit raise for the Clerk Adamson. Motion died for lack of a second. Motion by Even, seconded by Perry to approve Resolution 2022-11 setting pay with a 3% (police officers, public works employees and city hall staff) and a 5% merit raise for Clerk Adamson to begin July 1, 2022 and a 5% merit raise July 1, 2023. Roll call vote. Ayes – Three. Becker voted Nay.

Res 2022-11 setting pay

Motion by Becker, seconded by Even to approve Resolution 2022-12 approving workers compensation insurance with Iowa Municipal Workers Compensation Association (IMWCA). Roll call vote. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Motion by Becker, seconded Brustkern to approve Resolution 2022-13 approving transfers. Roll call vote. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Res. 2022-13 Transfers

Motion by Becker, seconded by Even to table a quote for a fence between the Splash Pad and Veteran's Park. Ayes – Four. Motion carried. A request was made by Veteran's Park committee to install a fence separating Veteran's Park and the Splash Pad. Council is concerned people will not be able to see through the proposed fence and would like a different fence.

Veterans Park/Splash Pad Fencing

Discussion was held on tile work at Schmitt Park. The intake is not working causing water to sit in the park and make it difficult to mow. PW Even explained that Hershberger tiling can come and tear it up to see what the problem is but can't give a quote until that is determined. Council is in favor of finding out what the problem is and PW Even will have report/quote for the next meeting.

Motion by Even, seconded by Perry to adjourn at 7:03 p.m. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.
