Motion by Even, seconded by Perry to approve the June 21, 2021 regular session agenda. Ayes - Four. Motion carried.

Motion by Frost, seconded by Becker to approve following items listed on the consent agenda: 1) Minutes of the June 7, 2021 regular meeting; 2) Payment of bills, receipts and transfers; 3) Utility Billing Reconciliation for the month of June 2021 and 4) Dew Drop amendment to Outdoor Service permit July 29, 2021 (Ragbrai).
