

REGULAR SESSION August 15, 2022

The City Council of Gilbertville, Iowa met in Regular Session Monday, August 15, 2022. Mayor Thome called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Council members present: Even, Perry, Brustkern, Even and Frost at 6:00 p.m. Quorum present.

Rita Becker gave the invocation and Mayor Thome led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Becker, seconded by Perry to approve the following items listed on the consent agenda: a) August 15, 2022 Agenda; b) Minutes from August 1, 2022 regular meeting; c) Payment of bills, transfers and receipts; d) Clerk/Treasurer Report for July 2022; e) Public Works Director/Assistant attendance at IRWA Conference October 5-6th and f) Approve Clerk and Deputy Clerk attendance at IMFOA Conference October 19-21st. Ayes – Five. Motion carried.

Ordinance 358 amending Alcoholic Beverages

Motion by Even, seconded by Frost to waive the second and third reading of Ordinance 358. Roll call vote. Ayes – Five. Motion carried.

Motion by Frost, seconded by Becker to approve Ordinance 358 for the final reading and adopt Ordinance 358. Roll call vote. Ayes – Five. Motion carried.

Reports:

Public Works Director Werner reported the tower inspection is scheduled and they will be painting the street lines this week and getting the handicap accessible sidewalk poured at Schmit Park in the next few weeks.

Chief Bovy explained a previous member of the department was on a leave of absence and would like to come back but since he lives out of the district it needs department and council approval. The department is in favor of his return. Chief Bovy will check with Evansdale Fire Chief to ensure he does not have a problem with this person being on Gilbertville Fire since he lives in their district. Approval will be placed on the next agenda.

Discussion was held on fencing for pools. Clerk Adamson will check with the Attorney to see if the city legally has to require them.
