The City Council of Gilbertville, Iowa met in Regular Session Monday, September 20, 2021. Mayor Thome called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Council members present: Even, Frost, Becker and Perry. Meinert was absent. Quorum present.

Pledge of Allegiance

Motion by Becker, seconded by Frost to approve the agenda. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Approve Agenda

Motion by Frost, seconded Perry to approve following items listed on the consent agenda: 1) Minutes of the September 7, 2021 regular meeting; 2) Payment of bills, transfers and receipts and 3) Clerk/Treasurer report for August 2021. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Motion by Perry, seconded by Frost to table Resolution 2021-2209 approving an agreement with Dunkerton Public Library to provide library services. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.

Motion by Even, seconded by Frost to waive the second and third readings and place on file final adoption of Ordinance 351 pertaining to 17.04 Council Meetings. Roll call vote. Ayes – Four. Motion carried.
